- A Math 10 and at least one Math 11 or 12 (Foundations, Pre-Calculus, Workplace, etc.).
- Physical and Health Education 10.
- Arts Education and/or Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (ADST) 10–12 (at least one class).
- Career Life Education 10 (usually in Grade 10).
- Career Life Connections + Capstone (Grade 12).
