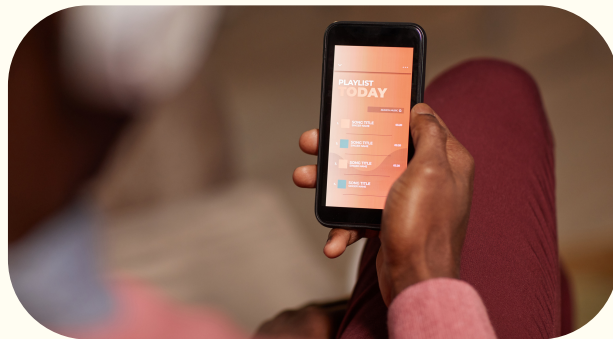

2025-2026 PSO General School Supply List

General supplies for secondary students can vary from class to class, but in general students from grades 8-12 require:

- 3 ring binder (2 or 3 inch) – 1
- Subject dividers – 1 pack of 5
- Lined paper – 1 pack of 400
- Pens (blue or black) – 2 packs of 5
- Pencils – 2 packs *Please remember students tend to need these throughout the year*
- Erasers – 2
- Pencil crayons – 1 pack of 24
- Scientific calculator – 1 *Available for purchase at the office \$15.00 each*
- Ruler – 1
- Highlighters – 2

Grade 8-10 and students taking a PE class in grade 11-12 require: a pair of gym (running) shoes, a change of shorts and/or sweatpants, a t-shirt and/or sweater, athletic socks, and a gym bag.

Other supplies may be requested by the classroom teacher.

Please contact the school if financial assistance for school supplies is needed for your child(ren).

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View – Student's Schedule

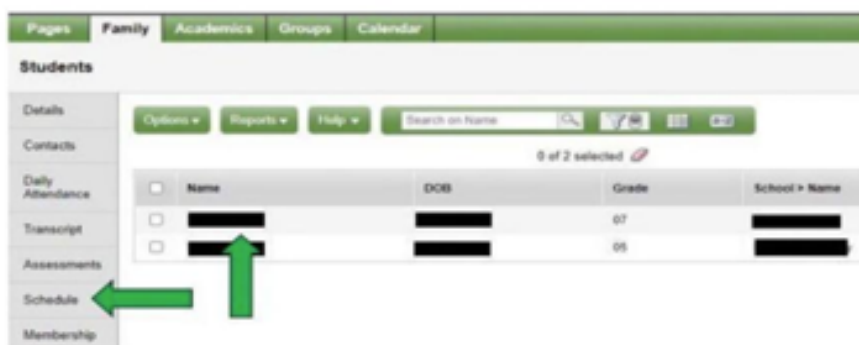
1) Visit - [MyEducation Login](#)

- Note - Both login username and password are case sensitive.
- If forgotten your password, please follow the **Password Recovery** directions on our website, hyperlink – [MyEd Support](#)

2) Select - **Family** tab on toolbar.

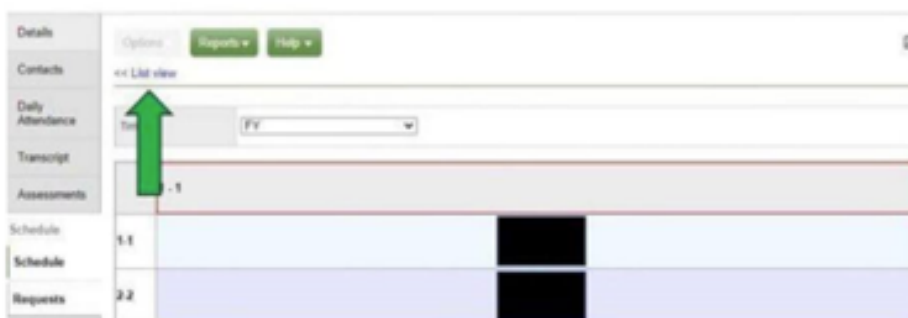


3) Select - student's **Name** and then select the **Schedule** tab on the left-hand side which will show students current courses.



4) There are two ways to view the schedule - **List View** or **Matrix View**.

- Can toggle between the two views to see the schedule.



- 5) To see all courses for the entire year, toggle to **Matrix view** and click on the **Funnel Icon** and select **All Records**



- 6) In **Matrix view** click on **Term** to sort the courses chronologically.



- 7) Log out once reviewed.

Reset your MyEd Password



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MyEducation - Reset

- MyEducation disables accounts after 90 days if unused and will prompt the user to reset their password using the security question per the [Password Recovery](#) directions, or if there were 3 invalid login attempts on the account.
- Once the email reset notification is received, please login on a desktop computer or laptop (not on a mobile device).

Reset:

- 1) Visit - [MyEducation Login](#)

- Note - Both login username and password are case sensitive.

- 2) Enter your **Login ID** and (temporary) **Password** (do not copy/paste the password, must be entered exactly as is case sensitive). Then click - **Log On**
- 3) After successfully logging into MyEd, the system will prompt to create a new password. Press **OK** and enter the **Current Password** (which is the temporary password).
- 4) Enter a **New Password** and **Confirm New Password**. Must include:
 - a) Minimum length is 8
 - b) At least one number
 - c) At least one capital and lowercase letter
 - d) At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number.
 - e) Cannot contain the word 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal ID, or only sequential letters or number.

- 5) Press **OK** (at bottom of popup) and the password has been reset.
- 6) **Security Preference Update** popup window opens next. Please complete this section.
 - Setting the security preference will make it possible for to use the - **I forgot my password** link that displays on the main login screen.

- This will allow the user to reset their account and have a temporary password sent to their email address.

- 7) After the **Security Preference Update** information has been entered, click - **Submit**.
- 8) After successfully logging in, you will be able to open and navigate into MyEducation BC.
 - Please make a note of your Login ID, new password and security preference answer for future reference.

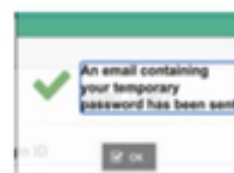
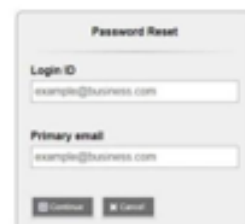
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MyEducation BC-Password Recovery

- Password recovery must be completed on a desktop computer or laptop (not on a mobile device)..

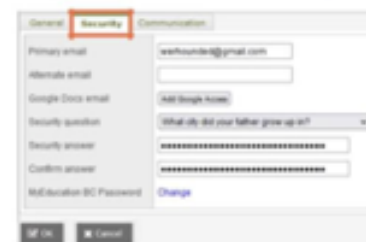
Password Recovery:

- 1) Visit – [MyEducation Login](#)
 - Note - All pop-ups must be enabled in the browser.
- 2) Click on the blue hyperlink - ***I forgot my password***
- 3) Password Reset popup - Enter your Login ID and your Primary email (same email on record at the school). Then click – ***Continue***.
 - Note - User login ID are case sensitive.
- 4) Security question popup window will generate. Enter your answer (exactly how it was entered as it is case sensitive), then click - ***Submit***.
 - NOTE - If the security question was not created or have forgotten the answer, then will be unable to reset your password. Please contact the school to request a MyEd account reset.
- 5) If the question answered correctly, a briefly green popup will appear.
- 6) An email will be sent from sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca with a temporary password. If the email was not received, please check the email "Junk" folder.
- 7) Return to the login screen - [MyEducation Login](#) and enter your Login ID and temporary password.
- 8) After successfully logging into MyEd, the system will prompt to create a new password. Press **OK** and enter the **Current Password** (which is the temporary password).
- 9) Enter a **New Password** and **Confirm New Password**. Must include:
 - a) Minimum length is 8
 - b) At least one number
 - c) At least one capital and lowercase letter
 - d) At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number.
 - e) Cannot contain the word 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal ID, or only sequential letters or number.
- 10) Press **OK** (at bottom of popup) and your password has been reset.
- 11) After successfully logging in, you will be able to open and navigate into MyEducation BC.



How to set up/change your security question:

- 1) After logging in, click on your name at the top right corner.
 - 2) Click on **Set preferences**, then click the **Security** tab on the popup window.
 - 3) Select a security question and enter your answer.
 - 4) Click **OK** to save.
- Please make a note of your Login ID, new password and security preference answer for future reference.

Parent User Guide for BC Services Card Authentication

Purpose

This resource is a user guide for parents, detailing how to log in to MyEducation BC using their BC Services Card. If you need assistance outside of the information contained in this resource, please see the BC Services Card Authentication FAQs.

Context: MyEducation BC has partnered with Service BC to enable a single method of signing on to MyEducation BC. Users now have two options for logging in to MyEducation BC:

1. Username and password
2. BC Services Card

Please note: The username and password option remains available to all users. Parents and students with a MyEducation BC account and BC Services Card now have a second login option, which is to log in using their BC Services Card. If you choose to connect your MyEducation BC account to your BC Services Card, you will no longer be able to log in to MyEducation BC using your username and password.

Parents With a MyEducation BC Account

Parents With a BC Services Card:

Parents who have a MyEducation BC account and a BC Services Card may use their BC Services Card to log in to their MyEducation BC account. If parents choose to log in to MyEducation BC account with their BC Services Card, they will no longer be able to log in to MyEducation BC using a username and password.

Upon opening [MyEducation BC](#), you will be prompted to either log in with your username and password OR with your BC Services Card. If you haven't logged in to MyEducation BC before, you will need to log in with your username and password at least once to activate your MyEducation BC account and reset your username and password.

To log in with BC Services Card:

1. [Setup the BC Services Card app on your mobile device.](#)
2. Once the BC Services Card app is setup on your mobile device, [log in to MyEducation BC](#), select "BC Services Card," and enter your name and password to connect your BC Services Card to your MyEducation BC account.

Contact your school/district if you need assistance with your MyEducation BC username and password or MyEducation BC account.

Contact the BC Services Card Tier 1 Help Desk at 1-888-356-2741 if you need assistance with your BC Services Card.



Please note: Parents must not connect their BC Services Card to their child's MyEducation BC account. Parents must only connect their BC Services Card to their personal MyEducation BC account. If a parent does not have a MyEducation BC account, they must not connect their BC Services Card to MyEducation BC.

If MyEducation BC believes you are trying to connect your BC Services Card to someone else's MyEducation BC account, you will receive the following warning:

The birthdate on your BC Services Card doesn't match the student's file at the school. Do not connect your BC Services Card with your child's login ID.

If you are a parent and your school/district does not use the MyEducation BC family portal, you do not have a MyEducation BC account and cannot access MyEducation BC.

If the warning message is incorrect, and you are trying to connect your BC Services Card to your own MyEducation BC account, please check that you are using your own BC Services Card and MyEducation BC login ID and password. If after checking and trying again you still receive this warning, click "Cancel" and contact your school/district for help.

Parents Without a BC Services Card:

Parents without a BC Services Card are only able to log in to MyEducation BC using their username and password. Contact your school/district if you need assistance with your MyEducation BC username and password or MyEducation BC account.

Parents With Dual Parent and Staff Roles MyEducation BC Accounts:

Parents whose MyEducation BC accounts have both parent and staff roles are not able to connect to MyEducation BC using their BC Services Card. Staff accounts, and parent accounts with dual parent and staff roles, are not yet able to support a single method of signing on to MyEducation BC with the BC Services Card.

Parents With More Than One MyEducation BC Account:

You can only connect your BC Services Card to one MyEducation BC account. If you have more than one MyEducation BC account, you may connect one of your MyEducation BC accounts to your BC Services Card, and you will use your username and password to log in to your other MyEducation BC accounts. Contact your school/district for support with your MyEducation BC account(s).

Parents Without a MyEducation BC Account

Parents without a MyEducation BC account cannot access MyEducation BC.
